MALAYSIA AIRPORT HOLDING BERHAD (MAHB) TOWARD AIRPORTS 4.0 INITIATIVE


Recent news on the utilization of face recognition at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) as one of the most non-intrusive biometrics leads to face recognition technology is becoming ever closer to people's daily lives. Evidence of this is that in 2000 the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) endorsed facial recognition as the most suitable biometrics for air travel.

Business processes have been modified with this new technology, and organizations are now working much more efficiently than ever. At the same time, technology has opened a new way of creating customer value allowing businesses to communicate and collaborate with customers beyond borders.

The face recognition systems will identify people by their face images. In contrast to traditional identification systems, face recognition systems establish the presence of an authorized person rather than just checking whether a valid identification (ID) or key is being used or whether the user knows the secret personal identification numbers (PINs) or passwords. The security advantages of using biometrics to check identification are as follows. It eliminates the misuse of lost or stolen cards, and in specific applications, it allows PINs to be replaced with biometric characteristics, which makes financial and computer access applications more convenient and secure.

Malaysia Airports Holdings Bhd's (MAHB) group already announced the initiative utilizing facial recognition technology to provide passengers with one single-token biometric identification authentication early last year. This is during the pandemic when our border is still not yet fully open. "We are making this technology available at the airport because we also need to restore confidence among air travel passengers, and we hope to gain the cooperation of our airline partners to integrate their processes to adapt to this available technology," MAHB said.

MALAYSIA AIRPORT HOLDING BERHAD (MAHB) TOWARD AIRPORTS 4.0 INITIATIVE



The technology will allow the passengers to go through their entire airport journey without showing their boarding passes at all touchpoints, from check-in right to the boarding gates. According to MAHB, the authentication process is expected to take about five seconds for each passenger at every touchpoint, thus shortening their airport journey considerably.

“The first phase of the technology roll-out is expected to be completed in 1H 2021, where 50 self-check-in kiosks, 20 check-in counters, and 56 eGates at security checkpoints and boarding gates at both KLIA Terminal 1 and Terminal 2 will be equipped with facial recognition technology,” he said.

MAHB said the Single Token Journey is a significant component of the Airports 4.0 initiative, one of several identified mission-critical projects despite constraints due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

THE HISTORY OF 'SOMU KA' IN JOHOR

Through this administration, policies for the people are formulated and implemented as well as Japanese propaganda can be disseminated to be understood by the people of Johor. In this way, it will be able to strengthen Japan's influence in the state of Johor and further facilitate Japan to utilize Johor's economic resources which have been strong before. Interestingly, through Somu Ka, monitoring of the use of vehicles and fuel for the Japanese administration in Johor is also done by the administration of this office. Through its administration as well, Japan prioritizes courses and training for staff so that they have specific skills based on the needs of the Japanese administration in Johor.

Among the focus of training and courses is learning Japanese. Through this department, matters related to the general public will be handled by them and inspectors of government offices will also be established so that the implementation of the administration can be carried out in a planned manner based on Japanese policies in the colonies.

THE HISTORY OF 'SOMU KA' IN JOHOR



By March 1942, Japanese military control in Johor was firmly established and at this time the Governor of Japan had begun to govern Johor. In Johor, Governor Itami has conducted his administration systematically, with the intention of highlighting Japan having a more structured administration and Johor will benefit from the implementation of this administrative strategy.

In the administrative hierarchy, the governor is the chief administrator. Based on the record, Zulfadli also displayed a chart of Japanese administration in Johor by seeing two main departments were created to facilitate Japanese administration at that time. The public administration department was created to regulate 37 more existing departments that were created under the administration of the Johor Government, in addition to increasing the effectiveness of the administration in all regions, the urban and rural sectors were also created by the Japanese administration.
